The following are the rules and regulations for the use of the Monterey County Peace Officers Association Pistol Range. The information contained herein is also posted on several signs on the Range property.

THE MONTEREY COUNTY PEACE OFFICER'S ASSOCIATION SHOOTING RANGE RULES

- The M. C. P. O. A. range is a member ship shooting range only and is not open to the public
- Normal shooting hours are 0800 to 1700 hours Monday through Friday
- Department night shooting hours are scheduled through the range master
- No shooting after 2000 hours according to Monterey County noise regulations
- This is a hand gun range only
- Rifles are not allowed
- Shotguns may be used at department training only
- Shotguns are not allowed at individual practice shoots
- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed at the range or range buildings
- All shooters and bystanders must wear ear and eye protection
- Close and lock the entry gate upon leaving

DEPARTMENT USE

- Provide own qualified Range Master
- Provide own targets
- Responsible for all injuries or damage to the range
- Prior to leaving shooters must pick up all trash and empty all trash barrels into the dumpster
- Prior to leaving shooters must pick up all brass
- Do not throw brass in the dumpster
- Leave brass by range office door
- Only two vehicles at the range, the range master vehicle and equipment vehicle
- Hand guns may be handled only on the firing line or at the safe barrels
- All weapons must remain unloaded, with actions open, behind the firing line
- Shooters may approach or leave the firing line only on the range masters command
- Shooters, who carry duty weapons, may reload and holster only on the firing line, at safe barrels, and on the range masters command
- Any misuse of the facilities will result in the loss of use of the range

INDIVIDUAL PRACTICE SHOOTS

- Members only and must be in good standing
- Members must possess a current M. C. P. O. A. card and present same if requested
- Members may accompany one guest
- Guests must be 14 years old or older to be present or to shoot at the range (see guest waiver)
- All members and guests must follow all safety rules and range rules
- Guests must sign the use waver, located to the left of the range office door
- Members must sign the guest use waver as the sponsor of a guest
- Pick up all trash and place in the dumpster
- Prior to leaving shooters must pick up all brass and leave the brass by range office door
- Safe shooting is no accident

**SHOOTING RANGE
RELEASE OF LIABILITY**

NOTICE: *Please read this form carefully. By signing this form, you will be giving up your right to sue the Monterey County Peace Officers Association, its officers, employees and agents for an injury you may receive while present at the pistol range.*

The Dangers of the Pistol Range

A pistol range can be a dangerous place. You may be injured or killed by ricocheting bullets and debris, powder burns, defective firearms or ammunition as well as by the negligent handling of a firearm by yourself or another person using the range. You may be injured or killed because of activities conducted at the adjacent public pistol and rifle range. You may suffer damage to your sight or hearing if you do not use adequate protection. In addition, there are the normal hazards associated with uneven surfaces, water, electrical wiring, vehicles, machinery, buildings and other fixtures on the premises. These are only some of the dangers you may face while present at the range.

Conditions for Being on the Pistol Range

The Monterey County Peace Officers Association (MCPOA) insists on your meeting two conditions before you may be present on its pistol range. First, you must have medical insurance to cover any treatment you may receive as a result of injuries you suffer while present at the range. Second, you must release MCPOA, its officers, employees and agents from liability for your death or for any injury or property damage you suffer while on the pistol range even if it is due to negligence. This means that you expressly assume the risk of all dangerous conditions, whether known or unknown, in or about the property and that you waive any and all notice of the existence of such conditions. Further, your release of liability applies not only to yourself but to your heirs, executors, personal representatives and assigns as well.

Agreement

In return for MCPOA allowing me to be present on and/or use its pistol range, I acknowledge that I have medical insurance that will substantially cover the cost of treatment for any injuries I may receive. I also agree to the release of liability as described above. I promise and agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless MCPOA, its officers, employees and agents from any and all liability, loss or damage they may suffer as a result of claims, demands, costs or judgments arising out of my presence at, going to or coming from, the pistol range, including liability for loss or damage caused either in whole or in part by negligence or other fault on the part of MCPOA, its officers, employees or agents.

I also understand that I must be at least 14 years of age to either be present at or use the range. I understand that if I am under 18 years of age I must have my parent or guardian complete this form before I am either present at or use the pistol range.

I promise and agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless MCPOA, its officers, employees and agents from any and all liability, loss or damage they may suffer as a result of claims, demands, costs or judgments arising out of the minor's presence at or use of the pistol range, including liability for loss or damage caused either in whole or in part by negligence or other fault on the part of MCPOA, its officers, employees or agents.
